















Prune most fruit trees, roses and other leafless trees and shrubs from December through January. WARNING: **Do not prune spring blooming shrubs and trees** such as lilac, quince, flowering cherry etc. until the blooming period is over.

Keep up your New Year's Resolution . . . join the Livermore-Amador Valley Garden Club (www.lavgc.org) and the Mt. Diablo Rose Society (mtdiablorosesociety.org).

Think Strawberry shortcake! By mid-month we'll have all the perennial vegetables and fruits. You can set out strawberries, rhubarb, raspberry, blackberry and many other cane fruits.

If you like **asparagus**, **horseradish and artichoke**s we have starts for those too. Come by and let us help you choose your favorites.

Set out winter blooming annuals for a garden filled with color. Choose primroses, pansies, Iceland poppies, ornamental cabbage and kale. Check with the staff.

It's to **plant garlic and shallots** from bulbs. We'll also have **bareroot onions** in early November. Stockton Reds are a favorite!!

CRAFTERNOONS







Winter Pruning Season Begins

As the temperatures drop and hold low for a couple of weeks, most deciduous trees and shrubs are ready for their annual pruning. Winter pruning season spans approximately mid-December through about Feb. 1st. Alden Lane Nursery has a few helpful resources for assisting you in this sometime overwhelming subject. First of all, please take advantage



of a number of **pruning classes** scheduled over the next month or so. (See our web page for a schedule.) We also have a great selection of tools and gloves and helpful pruning books. Our web page also includes pruning diagrams for guidance.

For pruning fruit trees, pick up a copy of a very handy pruning book titled, *How to Prune Fruit Trees* by Robert Sanford Martin. This book packs a wealth of information into its 90 pages, covering virtually every type of fruit tree and fruiting vine home gardeners will encounter. The book illustrates and explains in a brief format how each type of tree produces fruit and what pruning is required to help,

not hinder fruit production. Every fruit tree owner should have a copy.

As long as we are talking about pruners, **Felco Pruners** are our very favorite hand pruners. Felco shears lasting for decades. Felcos come in a variety of sizes and types (including left handed shears.) We have Felcos displayed where you can give them a test

drive. Come in and see them.

Finally in the line-up of pruning aids, what can be more helpful than a good pair of gardening gloves. **West County Gloves** offers a nice collection of well-made gloves that are comfortable and engineered to wear well. In addition to a good general purpose gardening glove, West County Gloves also produce the amazing "American Beauty" Gauntlet rose glove. Tested here at the nursery, this glove will allow you to thrust your hands into rose pruning chores without fear of thorns tearing up your hands. We have found the synthetic suede cloth completely stops thorns before reaching the skin. We would be happy to show you a pair.



Winter Evergreens **

In fall, a young person's fancy turns to . . . *evergreens*? Well maybe not, but it is a great time to select and enjoy hardy evergreen trees and shrubs, useful to form the backbone of your landscape.

Conifers:

Great for the ho-ho-ho time of year and and year round as well. Have some fun with the following varieties, guaranteed to add a unique flair to your landscape.

Deodar Cedar: the California Christmas tree! Grows tall, has soft green needles, a low water user

Dwarf Alberta Spruce: small, green, naturally cone shaped conifers for accent plantings; pots

Fat Albert Spruce: a beautiful living Christmas tree; slow growing with dense blue green foliage

Globe Spruce Patio Tree: small, round crowned, lollipop tree with striking blue foliage

Weeping Norway Spruce: unique evergreen accent. Pendulous, slow, with rich green needles

Hollies:

Hollies for the Holidays! Why not grow your own for festive winter arrangements using cut branches?

These two produce red berries on their own:

Berri Magic Kids Holly: glossy rich green leaves and abundant red berries

Berri Magic Royalty Holly: the male plant grown in the pot assures lots of bright red berries

Camellias & Reblooming Azaleas:

Light up your yard in the soft, cool light of winter with the large, bright blooms of hardy, evergreen **Camellias** & reblooming **Azaleas**. These shady-spot lovers thrive on the north and east sides of your house, or under the dappled shade from trees. Both thrive in slightly raised planting beds richly amended with *Azalea Planting Mix*. Regular fertilizing with *Camellia/Azalea Food* spring thru summer, and *Master Bloom Formula* during fall will yield a spectacular flower show.
